

STUDENT SELF-STUDY REGENTS REVIEW

Castle Learning provides students with the ability to practice entire Regents' exams from previous years as well as review areas of weakness identified by the student Self-Study reports. Students also can create additional practices from teacher assigned activities.

SELECT A REGENTS REVIEW – SELF STUDY

1. Click on **Self Study**
2. Click on the **Regents Exams** icon
3. Choose the content (Math, Science, Social Studies, English Language Arts)
NOTE: US History will find sampler exams under the Self-Study - Expert Mode – Social Studies – Sample Assignments – Search for Sampler
4. Click on the course
5. Click on the exam to start the Regents review

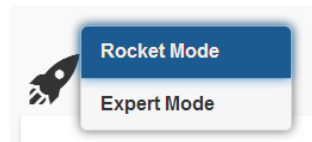
INCOMPLETE REVIEW (when you didn't get a chance to complete the Regents Review you started)

1. Click on **Incomplete Assignments**
2. Click on **Self Study**

REPORTS (View your results)

1. Click on **Reports**
2. Choose **Self Study Assignments**
3. Click on the assignment to create the report
4. Review the Topics. You will need to practice the topics that have a score with a red bar indicating below passing.

PRACTICE SPECIFIC AREAS OF WEAKNESS



Expert Mode

- Click on Self Study
- Change Rocket Mode to Expert Mode
- Choose Course
- Choose Topics
- Upper right, choose Regents course you are taking
- Set Levels to HS only then click on upper left to close box
- Use + to open a topic and continue to “drill down” with the + until you find the sub-topic identified in report that needs more study
- Check the box next to the sub-topic
- Scroll to the bottom and click on OK

Rocket Mode (by Grade/Topic)

- Click on Self Study
- Choose Course
- Choose any grade 9-12 (upper right)
- Click on + next to the Topic
- Choose Subtopic to start the practice assignment

5. Repeat the self-study of a Regents exam to see if you have improved from the last time. Repeat the review process of areas still identified as weaknesses.

PRACTICE ASSIGNMENTS FROM TEACHER ASSIGNMENTS

Students also can create additional practices from teacher assigned activities which identify areas of weakness in the student reports. The teacher can change the mode to Review Only for the students to view the results. This allows the student to view the report and look at the data. If students feel they need more practice, they can select a check box by the topics or standards that appear to need more work and then generate another practice assignment.

TEACHER ASSIGNMENT – STUDENT REVIEW OF COMPLETED ASSIGNMENT

1. From Student Center, click on **Reports**
2. Under the section **Assignments from your teacher** click on **Completed Assignments**
3. You will be able to view the assignment results if the teacher has allowed access
4. Click on the assignment you wish to review
5. Scroll down to review each question and any comments the teacher has made from a constructed response
 - a. Green – correct
 - b. Yellow – correct on retry (only on open mode assignments)
 - c. Red – wrong (open mode wrong twice or quiz mode wrong only try)
6. Click on the question number to view the question and teacher feedback for CR
7. Use **Next** to advance to next question or **X** (upper left of window) to close and select a different question

TEACHER ASSIGNMENT – STUDENT GENERATED PRACTICE ASSIGNMENT

1. From Student Center, click on **Reports**
2. Under the section **Assignments from your teacher** click on **Completed Assignments**
3. You will be able to view the assignment results if the teacher has allowed access
4. Click on the assignment you wish to review
5. Scroll down to the **Total** section
6. Click **Topics** or **Standards**
7. You will see where weaknesses have been identified by a Grade and an indication of Red bar (below) and Blue bar (above) expected passing 65% of that item

8. Click the check box next to any item you want to more questions to practice.
9. Scroll down and click on

10. This will give you a practice assignment with multiple questions around 3-5 per check box. You will have two tries to answer the question correctly before moving to the next question. Make sure you use the Hint and Vocab to help you if you get it wrong on the first try.

NOTE: If you don't finish the Practice Assignment you can go back to Incomplete Assignments, click on Practice Assignments and you will be shown all your practice assignments.

11. You can review results from any Practice Assignment

- a. Select Reports
- b. Click on Completed Assignments
- c. Click on the original assignment
- d. Scroll down to the bottom under Practice Assignments
- e. Click on the Practice Assignment which is labeled with the original assignment name and number of practices (Practice #)
